

GLEASON MEMORIAL LIBRARY INTERNET POLICY

1. All patrons must have a signed Internet Access Contract on file at the library.
2. Children aged 18 and under must be supervised by an adult or have written permission of parent or guardian.
3. Internet access is available on a first come, first served basis for 30 minutes at a time; unless otherwise authorized by the librarian in charge.
4. Internet computers will not be used for illegal activity, to access illegal materials or to access materials that by local community standards would be obscene.
5. Installation, downloading, or modification of software is prohibited.
6. No food and or drinks at Internet workstations.
7. Users will respect copyright laws and licensing agreements.
8. Users will not attempt to gain unauthorized access to restricted files or damage or modify computer equipment or software.
9. Internet privileges will be restricted for users with unpaid library fines or printing charges.
