

Trustee Meeting
Gleason Memorial Library
September 20, 2018

The Gleason Memorial Library board met on September 20, 2018 with board members Lisha Scifres, Renee Yocum, Mary Grace and Pam Bell attending. Lisha called the meeting to order at 5:10 p.m. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. The Friends of the Library account showed a balance of \$22,057.50 with \$1,575.26 in savings.

Renee reported that Mad Science has been booked for the summer reading program. She has not heard from OKC Zoo. Critter Tales would come for \$225. A Puppet Show is being researched.

OK Virtual Library report showed that 44 eBooks/audiobooks have been used.

The afterschool programs which are being presented by the library need several items for teaching including lids, beans and glass jars.

For fundraising, baskets are needed. Extra fundraising may be needed for the \$1500 OK Virtual Library annual fee next year.

The theme for the library's Trunk or Treat table in October is Alice in Wonderland and old tea cups are needed. Renee will be Queen of Hearts and Desiree will be Alice.

Renee was a panelist on a webinar program on September 19 titled Libraries and Healthy Communities: Edge Helps Public Libraries Promote Health Literacy through Technology. It went well. Participants from California, Indiana, Iowa, Missouri, North Carolina, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, Texas, Washington D.C. and Virginia attended and all stayed connected until the conclusion.
